## Lesson Assessments

## All assessments are PROGRESSIVE.

Each lesson assessment builds upon a previous assessment: included facts are those covered in THAT lesson and prior lessons <u>only</u>. Students are not tested over facts that they have not covered, creating a sense of comfort and confidence while test-taking.

## All assessments are VERSATILE.

All lessons utilize one of the four Factivation!™ strategies: RULE, TRICK, CHANT, or CONNECTION.

- \* Assessment A provides no strategy prompts.
- \* Assessment B provides a strategy prompt for each fact.

## Assessments may be given in one of four ways:

- 1) Whole Page (with teacher-determined time limit)
- 2) Whole Page given BY ROW.
  - \* This method may reduce stress for anxious test-takers.

    Suggestion: If timed, 30 seconds/row. Keep all susequent rows covered.
- 3) Half Page
  - \* Once students understand the commutative property, it is possible to fold or cut the assessment in half and administer only the top or bottom portion. Assessments are carefully constructed so that each half can be administered independent of the other and provide an accurate view of student knowledge.
- 4) Half Page given BY ROW.
