

Lesson Assessments

All assessments are PROGRESSIVE.

Each lesson assessment builds upon a previous assessment: included facts are those covered in THAT lesson and prior lessons only. Students are not tested over facts that they have not covered, creating a sense of comfort and confidence while test-taking.

All assessments are VERSATILE.

All lessons utilize one of the four Factivation!™ strategies: RULE, TRICK, CHANT, or CONNECTION.

- * Assessment A provides no strategy prompts.
- * Assessment B provides a strategy prompt for each fact.

Assessments may be given in one of four ways:

- 1) Whole Page (with teacher-determined time limit)
- 2) Whole Page given BY ROW.

** This method may reduce stress for anxious test-takers.*

Suggestion: If timed, 30 seconds/row. Keep all subsequent rows covered.

- 3) Half Page

** Once students understand the commutative property, it is possible to fold or cut the assessment in half and administer only the top or bottom portion.*

Assessments are carefully constructed so that each half can be administered independent of the other and provide an accurate view of student knowledge.

- 4) Half Page given BY ROW.
