### Tips for Making Flipbooks

#### IMPORTANT

From Adobe, please make sure the Page Scaling is set to "None" in the print dialog box before printing!

1. Do a double-sided copy of flipbook "cover" and "inside". *Note: The scissors icon may be used to determine the TOP of the cover page.*
2. Fold the flipbook once vertically and once horizontally. Then unfold.
3. Locate the scissors icon and make a thin **DOUBLE** cut on either side of the fold, to the center. Snip.
4. Fold flaps down and close booklet.
